

Chinese Crested

Pedigree Breed Health Survey

Forms were received representing 46 living dogs & 1 deceased dog.

Mortality results

A total of 1 death was reported, representing 0.02% of all deaths reported in the Pedigree Breed Health survey. The age of death for the Chinese Crested was 9 years.

Morbidity results

The 46 live Chinese Cresteds represented 0.11% of total dogs in the survey. The median age of live dogs for the breed was 4 years (Table 2). Of the 46 Chinese Cresteds which the survey covers, 36 had reported no conditions and 10 reported affected by at least one condition (min = 1 condition(s), max = 3 conditions), giving a total of 17 incidents of conditions.

The gender, neuter status and age of neutering summary statistics for Chinese Cresteds are shown in Table 3. There were 36 dogs with responses for Body Condition displayed in Table 4.

The median age the dogs were first affected by a condition was 4 years (min = 0 years, max= 6 years, Figure 3). The ages for the most common conditions is displayed in Figure 4. Table 5 shows the reported disease conditions for the Chinese Crested.

Summary

From the dogs surveyed, most Chinese Cresteds were not affected by a disease condition (78.26%). The most commonly reported disease condition in live dogs was dermatitis. The only reported cause of death was pancreatic tumour.
